With reference to the abovementioned application, please be advised that the Gauteng Department of Agriculture and Rural Development (GDARD) have decided to grant authorisation.

A letter of notification of from GDARD dated 17 February 2011 (Office of the HOD / 000015) was received by our offices via facsimile on Friday 18 February.

In terms of Regulation 10(2) of the Environmental Impact Regulations (2006) this notices serves as formal notification of the Environmental Authorisation as provided by GDARD.

You are further notified that the Environmental Authorisation may be appealed (National Environmental Management Act, Act 107 of 1998 / Regulation 385 / GN #28753 dated 21 April 2006 / Chapter 7) and the procedure for appeal is as follows:

Section 61(b)

An appeal against a decision must be lodged with (b) the MEC, as the MEC is the relevant competent authority for the activity in relation to which the decision was taken.

Section 62(1)

A person affected by a decision referred to in regulation 60(1) who wishes to appeal against the decision, must lodge a notice of intention to appeal with the MEC, within 10 days after that person has been notified in terms of these Regulations of the decision.

(3) If an appellant is a person other than an applicant, the appellant must serve on the applicant-

(a) a copy of the notice referred to in sub-regulation (1);

(b) a notice indicating where and for what period the appeal submission will be available for inspection by the applicant.

Submission of appeals

Section 63(1)

(b) An appeal lodged with the MEC must be submitted to the provincial department responsible for environmental affairs in the relevant province.

(2) An Appeal must be:-

a) on an official form published by or obtainable from the relevant department;

b) Accompanied by:-

i) a statement setting out the grounds of appeal;

ii) supporting documentation which is referred to in the appeal and which is not in the possession of the MEC;

iii) a statement by the appellant that regulation 62(2) or (3) has been complied with together with copies of the notices referred to in that regulation; and

iv) the prescribed appeal fee, if any.(3) When submitting an appeal, the appellant must take int account any guidelines applicable to appeals.

Time within which appeals must be lodged

Section 64(1)

An appeal must be submitted to the relevant department within 30 days of the lodging of the notice of intention to appeal referred to in regulation 62(1).

Section 64(2)

The MEC may, in writing, on good cause extend the period within which an appeal must be submitted.

Responding statements

Section 65(1)

A person or organ of state which receives a notice in terms of regulation 62(2), or an applicant who receives a notice in terms of regulation 62(3), may submit to the MEC, a responding statement within 30 days from the date the appeal submission was made available for inspection in terms of that section.

2(a) A person who submits a responding statement in terms of sub-regulation (1) must serve a copy of the statement on the appellant.

(b) If a respondent introduces any new information not dealt with in the appeal submission of the appellant, the appellant is entitled to submit an answering statement to such new information to the MEC, within 30 days of receipt of the responding statement.

(c) The appellant must serve a copy of the answering statement on the respondent who submitted the new information.

Please also note that a copy of the Environmental Authorisation is available upon request from the office of the Environmental Assessment Practitioner (EAP).
